

Measure AA Program Recommendations

Create New 10 Year Program element as part of the "PAMP" - Pavement Asset Management Program

- "SRRP" Secondary Roads Rehabilitation Program
- Utilize Measure AA funds to focus on rehabilitation and resurfacing of secondary roads (major and minor collectors)
- Improve PCI rating to 50 (Fair)



Recommendation for FY26

Consider moving forward with an "Early Success" Projects Plan

- 14 Projects
- Resurface approximately 9 miles of County Road
- Complete within one year

Amount Requested: \$7.6 million

Asphalt Resurfacing: \$5.6 million

- 1. Vierra Canyon Rd, SR-156 to 1 mile east
- 2. San Benancio Rd, SR-68 to Harper Canyon Rd
- 3. San Benancio Rd, mile post 1.0 to mile post 2.0
- 4. Old Stage Rd, San Jerardo to Alisal Rd
- 5. Paraiso Springs Rd, Arroyo Seco Rd to Foothill Rd
- 6. Bradley Rd, Bridge to Salinas St (w/Fire Station Loop)
- 7. Blackie Road, SR 183 to Del Monte Avenue

Blade-Lay Projects (performed by County maintenance forces): \$1.5 million

- 1. Central Ave, US-101 to Jolon Rd
- 2. Wild Horse Rd, various locations
- 3. Lonoak Rd, King City to 1 mile east
- 4. Parkfield Coalinga Rd, various locations

Amount Requested: \$7.6 million

San Lucas community parcel: \$70,000

 Purchase of vacant parcel adjacent to San Lucas Library for future community park

Neighborhood Traffic Management Program pilot: \$0.2 million

 Continue with traffic calming pilot projects in the County


Augmented Litter Abatement: \$0.23 million

Blade Lay Resurfacing Projects

Resurfacing of low-volume roads in southern Monterey County

- > Cost effective resurfacing for roads with low traffic volumes
- ➤ Work performed by county crew during summer/fall months
- > Asphalt mix only available in southern Monterey County
- > Requires a chip seal after 1-2 years to prolong rideability






Measure AA PWFP Annualized Program First Full Year FY27

- I. Targeted Secondary Roads (Major/Minor Collectors) Resurfacing Program
 - > \$10 Million per year
- II. Augment Annual Seal Coat Program
 - > \$1 Million per year
- III. Augment Force Account Paving Program (Blade Lay)
 - > \$1.5 Million per year
- IV. Augment Road Drainage Improvements Capacity
 - > \$1.5 Million per year
- V. Augment Traffic Management and Safety Program
 - > \$500 Thousand per year
- **Total Request: \$14.5 Million**



Neighborhood Traffic Management Program

Program to identify, assess, and respond to neighborhood traffic and operations concerns, including vehicle speeds and traffic calming, multimodal use, circulation management, signing and striping enhancements, and vertical and horizontal measures for select areas.

Approx. Cost: \$250,000 per year



Amount Requested: \$7.6 million

- Asphalt Resurfacing: \$5.6 million
- Blade-Lay Projects (performed by County maintenance forces): \$1.5 million
- San Lucas community parcel: \$70,000
- Neighborhood Traffic Management Program pilot: \$0.2 million
- Augmented Litter Abatement: \$0.23 million

FY26 Adopted Budget Commitment: approx. \$4.3 million

Measure AA collections (to date): approx. \$14.1 million

Therefore, with this proposal, <u>approx. \$2.2 million remaining for other purposes</u>
