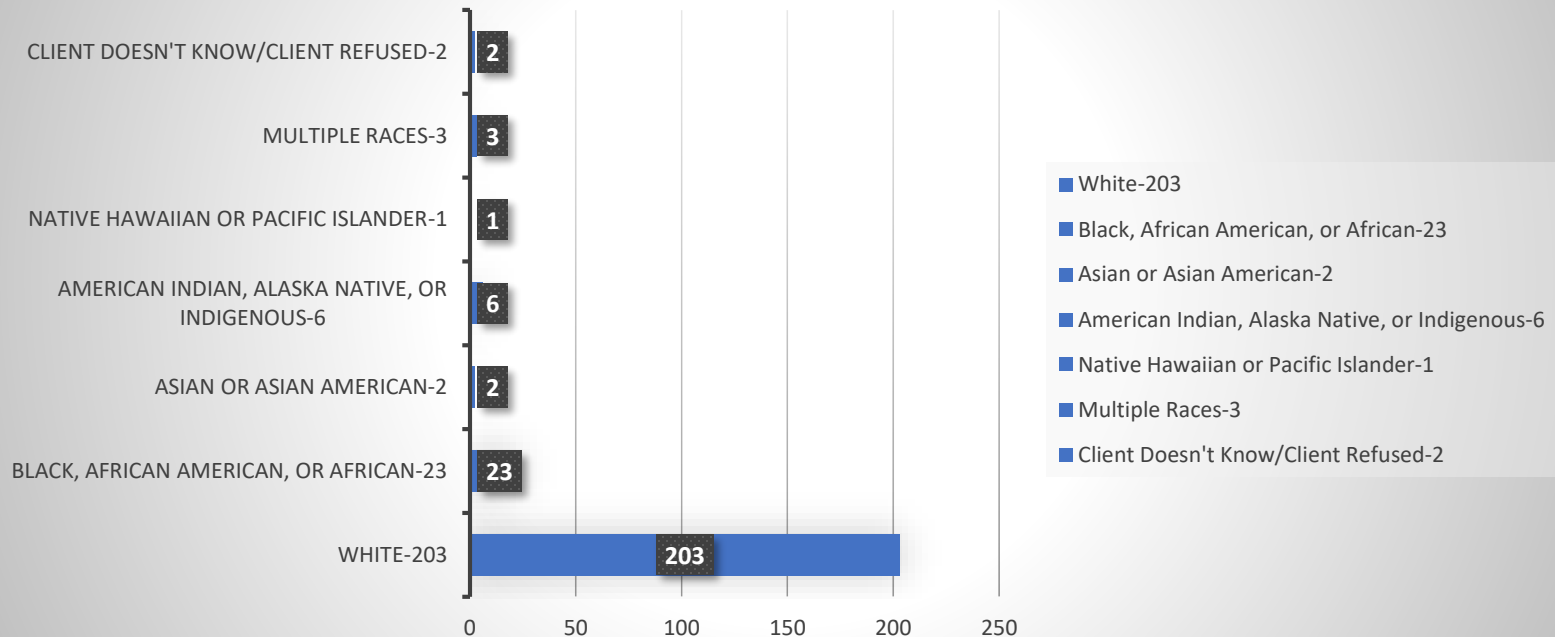
Most Commonly Served Age Groups

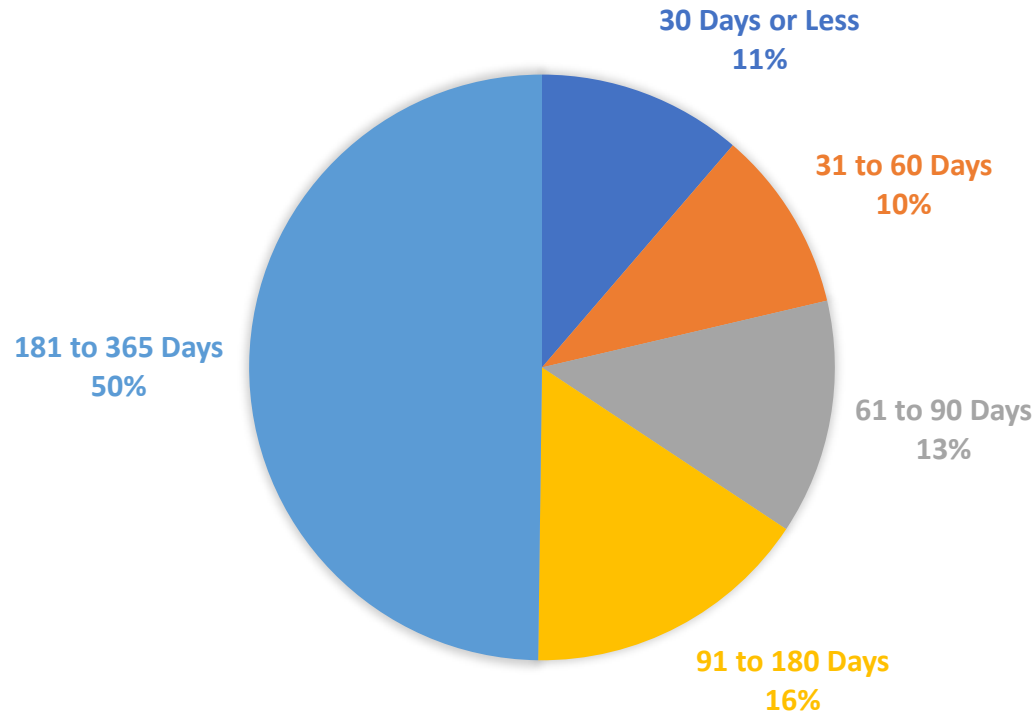

Housing Partnerships

- BACS service model focuses on quickly addressing housing barriers while exploring partnerships with landlords and property management companies
- Housing connections are based on the participants income and housing needs
- After care services support housing sustainability which reduces returns to the system
- To date BACS has partnered with over 40 landlords and property managers

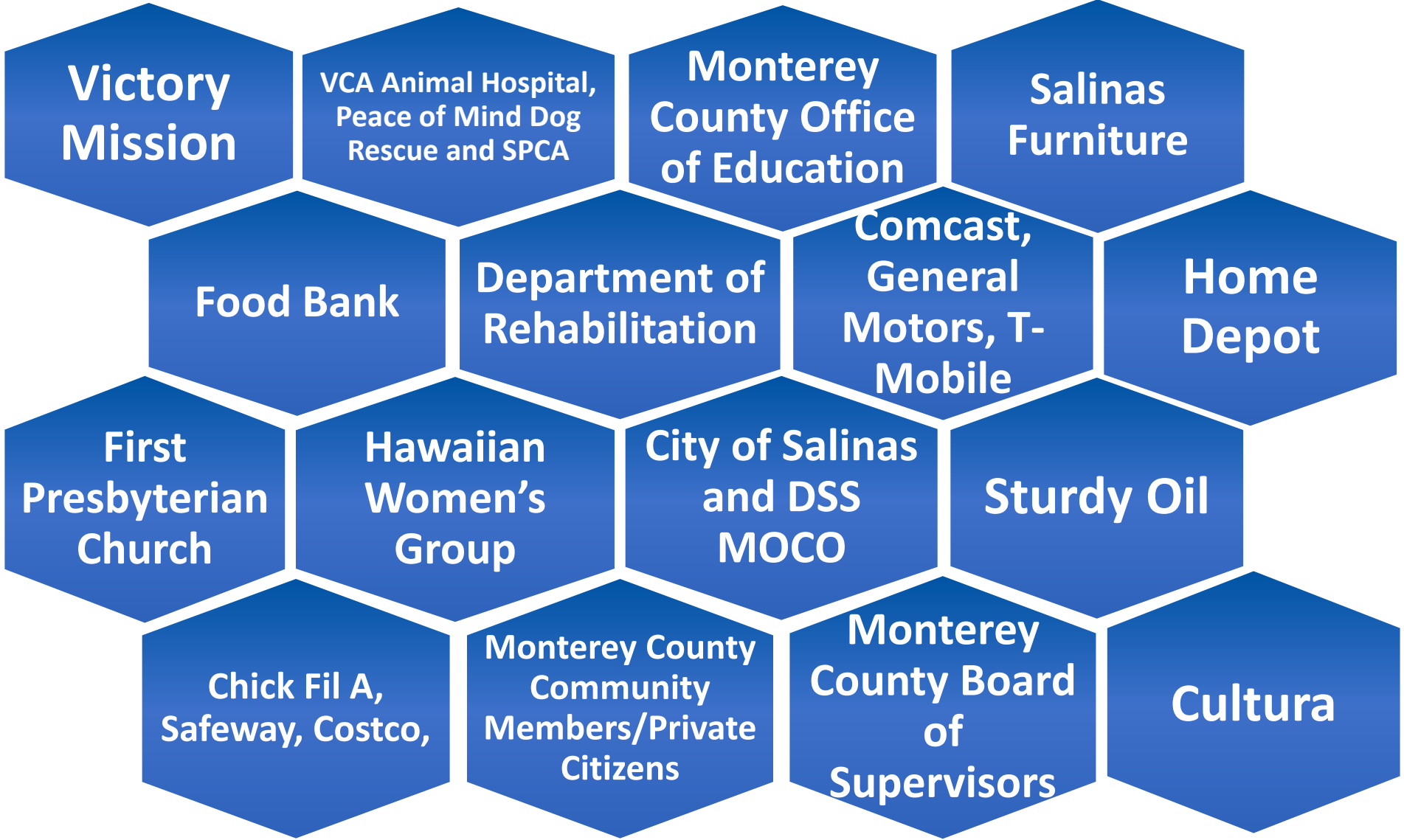
