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SOLICITATION DETAILS

1.0 INTENT

- 1.1 The County of Monterey Department of Public Works, Facilities and Parks (PWFP), hereinafter referred to as “County”, is soliciting proposal packages from qualified organization(s), hereinafter referred to as “CONTRACTOR(s)”, to provide litter abatement services to address illegal dumping of household, commercial and industrial waste items on County roads and public lands, including but not limited to waste collection and illegal dumping mitigation throughout the County of Monterey and extraordinary services such as the collection and disposal of homeless encampment debris. Interested CONTRACTOR(s) are to submit their proposals per this Request for Proposals (RFP) #10956.
- 1.2 Proposals will be evaluated by a selection panel to select CONTRACTOR(s) to negotiate an AGREEMENT(s) with the County.
- 1.3 CONTRACTOR(s) will perform litter abatement and cleanup at the direction of PWFP. PWFP will coordinate with the Health Department’s Environmental Health Bureau (EHB) on selecting qualified CONTRACTOR(s). The anticipated timeframe to award AGREEMENT(s) and start work is May 1, 2026.
- 1.4 This solicitation is not intended to create an exclusive service AGREEMENT.

2.0 BACKGROUND

- 2.1 The County of Monterey (County) is located on the Central Coast of California approximately 120 miles south of San Francisco. The County is approximately 3,771 square miles.
- 2.2 The County operates a Litter Abatement Program (Program), which provides for the collection and disposal of litter, debris, and materials dumped illegally along County roads, public rights-of-way, and on public lands. Annually, the Program removes 400-500 tons of household and industrial materials from County roadways and operates seven (7) days a week.
- 2.3 County is soliciting written proposals from qualified companies hereinafter referred to as “CONTRACTOR(s)”, that can provide the required professional partnership services to assist with litter abatement and pick-up.
- 2.4 The Program is a partnership between PWFP, EHB, Salinas Valley Solid Waste Authority (SVSWA) also known as Salinas Valley Recycles and Monterey Regional Waste Management District (MRWMD) dba ReGen Monterey, and CONTRACTOR(s), with multiple components.
- 2.5 EHB administers the Unified Franchise Agreement (UFA) For the Exclusive Collection of

Solid Waste, Recyclables and Organic Waste in Unincorporated Monterey County between the County of Monterey and USA Waste of California, Inc. DBA Carmel Marina Corporation (Commonly known as Waste Management, Inc.) for solid waste hauling and recycling services in the unincorporated area of the County of Monterey. EHB will work with the waste management districts and CONTRACTOR(s) to expand more frequent community clean ups Countywide and will negotiate additional cleanup events and expanded road cleanup response. EHB is working to expand outreach efforts to reduce illegal dumping through the illegal dumping and litter abatement task force.

2.6 RFP #10956 will establish a Program professional partnership to assist with litter abatement and pick-up. The County seeks CONTRACTOR(s) who will abide by all local, State, and Federal regulations and who are also capable of providing all labor, materials, tools, equipment, and supervision, while providing litter abatement services.

2.7 Waste collection and illegal dumping mitigation throughout the County includes, but is not limited to, matter not part of the highway facility (litter), such as:

2.7.1 Trash, scrap metals, recyclables, (plastic, glass products, paper products) wood, household waste, vegetation debris, auto parts, trash thrown from the windows of passenger vehicles and from trucks with uncovered loads, rubber products, e.g. tires, other large bulky items, spot litter, and dump sites.

2.7.2 Bulky items, which can be discarded materials such as household appliances (including refrigerators), furniture, carpets, mattresses, white goods, clothing, un-mounted tires, and oversized green waste such as tree trimmings and large branches, and similar large items which can be handled by two (2) people; or some combination of such items in a container, construction, and demolition debris.

2.7.3 Spot litter is a small dump site that often contains household waste materials.

2.7.4 Dump sites may contain large or bulky items. Illegal dumping, also called open dumping, midnight dumping, or fly dumping is also a significant source of trash on or near the roadways. Dumping differs from littering in the amount of material, type of materials (hazardous), who dumps it, and the underlying reasons for this behavior.

2.8 County will grant CONTRACTOR(s) the exclusive franchise, right, privilege, and duty during the term of the AGREEMENT and any extension thereof to collect and transport the litter to the facilities designated in the AGREEMENT.

- 3.9 No Pre-Proposal Meeting/Site Tour: A Pre-Proposal Meeting/Site Tour will not be held for this RFP. It is the responsibility of the CONTRACTOR(s) to become familiar with the “Request for Service” locations and needs described in this RFP. It is the County’s expectation that all litter abatement items identified in this RFP will be addressed in the CONTRACTOR(s) proposal.

- 4.3 The deadline for submitting written questions regarding this solicitation is indicated in the **CALENDAR OF EVENTS** herein. Questions submitted after the deadline will not be answered.
- 4.4 Only answers to questions communicated by formal written addenda will be binding.
- 4.5 Prospective CONTRACTOR(s) shall not contact County officers or employees with questions or suggestions regarding this solicitation except through the primary contact person listed above. **Any unauthorized contact may be considered undue pressure and cause for disqualification of the CONTRACTOR(s).**

5.0 SCOPE OF WORK

- 5.1 **CONTRACTOR's Minimum Work Performance Percentage:** CONTRACTOR shall perform with their own organization AGREEMENT work amounting to not less than fifty percent (50%) of the original total AGREEMENT not to exceed sum, except that any designated 'Specialty Items' may be performed by subcontract and the amount of any such 'Specialty Items' so performed may be deducted from the original total AGREEMENT price before computing the amount of work required to be performed by CONTRACTOR. CONTRACTOR shall not assign, subcontract, sell, or otherwise transfer its interest or obligations in this AGREEMENT without the prior written consent of County.
- 5.2 CONTRACTOR(s) will be given a list of "Request for Service" locations and will be providing on-call services.
- 5.3 CONTRACTOR(s) shall remove and legally dispose of litter from County roads, including shoulders, public rights-of-way, and on public lands, excluding the traveled lanes and shoulders next to barriers and taken to a suitable landfill or refuse service.
- 5.4 CONTRACTOR(s) shall have the necessary qualifications and experience to fulfill the requirements as indicated by the County.
- 5.5 CONTRACTOR(s) may be required to walk long distances while removing the litter.
- 5.6 CONTRACTOR(s) shall provide notice in writing by letter or email whenever any inclement conditions preclude litter pick-up. CONTRACTOR shall not be paid for such cancellation.

- 5.6.1 Coordinate with the designated County contact to reschedule a designated work restart day when scheduled day falls on a recognized holiday, such as Christmas or New Year's Day.
- 5.7 CONTRACTOR(s) may, on occasion, need to remove a major accumulation of plant or other material that will interfere with litter pick-up and is not included in this scope. A quote shall be submitted to the designated County contact. Work shall not begin until work is approved and a written Notice to Proceed is issued by the County.
- 5.8 CONTRACTOR(s) must supply and supervise qualified personnel to complete daily work/project assignments.
 - 5.8.1 CONTRACTOR(s) must have a foreman responsible for the work crew at all times.
 - 5.8.2 CONTRACTOR(s) foreman must be able to communicate effectively with County personnel.
- 5.9 CONTRACTOR(s) will adhere to appropriate safety precautions and requirements needed to do the assigned job.
- 5.10 CONTRACTOR(s), in the course of any work assignment, shall not impede County business, create a nuisance, or endanger County employees and/or the public.
- 5.11 CONTRACTOR(s) is expected to work hours that may vary due to the location of the work assignment.
 - 5.11.1 Specified work time(s) may be required.
 - 5.11.2 Work performed must be approved by the requesting County contact.
- 5.12 CONTRACTOR(s) shall ensure that all services, costs, and materials must, at minimum, meet the specifications for the State of California, State Contractors Board, the California Division of Occupational Safety and Health (CAL/OSHA) regulations and all other applicable regulations.
- 5.13 CONTRACTOR(s) is to ensure that the insurance and required licenses under both state and local jurisdictions are current during the full term of the AGREEMENT.
- 5.14 The selected CONTRACTOR(s) shall:
 - 5.14.1 Perform all work in a professional manner by skilled, experienced workers and be familiar with all best management practices for litter pick-up and disposal.
 - 5.14.2 Furnish all Personal Protective Equipment (PPE) to their employees for the cleaning task and working in high-speed, high volume roadways in compliance with the California Manual of Uniform Traffic Control Devices (CA-MUTCD),

CAL/OSHA and others, including, but not limited to, PPE safety vests (class II/III), nitrile gloves, puncture-resistant gloves, eye protection, ear protection, face masks, safety-toed shoes and other appropriate PPE. County will not supply uniforms or above-mentioned PPE.

- 5.14.3 Follow the procedures outlined in EXHIBIT B - SAFETY MEETING AND WORK PROCEDURES.
- 5.14.4 Provide remediation of vacant homeless encampments.
- 5.14.5 Provide all sanitation facilities and supplies to its employees (water, poison oak repellent, etc.)
- 5.14.6 Adhere to “Part 6, Temporary Traffic Control” of the CA-MUTCD.
- 5.14.7 Provide all safe work zone devices for its employees pursuant to the CA-MUTCD, such as traffic control signage, cones, etc.
- 5.14.8 Furnish all labor and equipment required to fulfill the AGREEMENT at no additional expense to the County.
- 5.14.9 Provide a monthly summary of work performed and identify any issues.
- 5.14.9.1 CONTRACTOR(s) shall provide reports that break down the quantity and tonnage of the different types of debris (see EXHIBIT C – LITTER LOG FORM) and electronically submit on a monthly basis to:

- 5.14.10 Upon receiving a request for work from the County, County contact shall provide a location delineating the limits of the individual litter cleanup task (refer to EXHIBIT A – COUNTY OF MONTEREY 2025 MAINTAINED MILEAGE BOOK) and utilize the online County Maintained Roads link at <https://maps.co.monterey.ca.us/portal/apps/instant/minimalist/index.html?appid=c07a67cca9d94c69a84ad3b1656a85e8> to determine public lands and road rights-of-way as a guide.
- 5.14.11 CONTRACTOR(s) shall not commence work until a formal Notice to Proceed has been issued by County in writing, which may include a work schedule and start date.
- 5.14.12 All work shall be performed in conformance with all applicable County, State and Federal laws relevant to the specific project scope.

6.0 AGREEMENT TERM

- 6.1. The term of the AGREEMENT will be for an initial term of three (3) years with the option to extend the AGREEMENT for up to two (2) additional years.
 - 6.1.1. County is not required to state a reason if it elects not to renew or extend the AGREEMENT.
- 6.2. If the AGREEMENT includes options for renewal or extension, **CONTRACTOR(s) must commence negotiations for any desired rate changes a minimum of ninety (90) days prior to the expiration of the AGREEMENT.**
 - 6.2.1. Both parties shall agree upon rate changes in writing.
- 6.3. The AGREEMENT shall contain a clause that provides that County reserves the right to cancel the AGREEMENT, or any extension of the AGREEMENT, without cause, with a thirty (30)-day written notice, or immediately, with cause.

7.0 QUALIFICATION REQUIREMENTS

- 7.1 Interested firms must meet ALL of the following qualification requirements in order to be considered by County:
 - 7.1.1 CONTRACTOR shall ensure that all services, costs, and materials comply, at a minimum, with the specifications for the State of California and CAL/OSHA regulations, as applicable.
 - 7.1.2 CONTRACTOR shall maintain all required licenses, certifications, and insurance in full force and effect, in compliance with applicable state and local jurisdictions, throughout the entire term of the AGREEMENT.
 - 7.1.3 CONTRACTOR shall possess the necessary qualifications, knowledge, and expertise to perform the services outlined in Section 5.0, Scope of Work.
 - 7.1.4 CONTRACTOR shall comply with all applicable laws, ordinances, rules and regulations for the services.

8.0 PROPOSAL PACKAGE REQUIREMENTS

8.1. CONTENT AND LAYOUT:

CONTRACTOR shall possess all permits, licenses, and professional credentials necessary to supply products, and the ability to deploy devices and equipment to perform services as specified under RFP #10956.

Personnel Qualification Statement: CONTRACTOR shall attach the organizational chart of the team that will provide services as specified under RFP #10956. The chart should show the names and roles of all key personnel.

CONTRACTOR shall include listing of *each* qualified individual staff member (supervisory and technician) assigned to perform services described in Section 5.0, Scope of Work, including a description of the following:

1. Technical expertise including all licenses/certifications and issue dates
2. Relevant experience
3. Dispatch location (site address)

Project Experience and References: CONTRACTOR shall describe its demonstrated capability, including length of time it has provided the services requested in this solicitation.

CONTRACTOR shall provide three (3) similar work examples and references in **ATTACHMENT A – PERSONNEL QUALIFICATION STATEMENT, PROJECT EXPERIENCE AND REFERENCES** for which it provided similar services as described in Section 5.0, Scope of Work (preferably California State or local government agencies) within the last five (5) years. Information provided should demonstrate work experience with litter abatement services for projects of various sizes and scope, and governmental agency work experience. Examples should demonstrate CONTRACTOR’s capacity and expertise to meet customer needs, and should include at a minimum:

CONTRACTOR shall provide a complete list of equipment owned by CONTRACTOR and available for services as specified under RFP #10956. Include a statement describing alternate solution to provide services under this AGREEMENT in the event of mechanical failure.

Section 6, Technical Aspects of Proposal:

CONTRACTOR shall provide a written and signed statement in this section which confirms that their proposal package is inclusive of all elements necessary to complete the services being requested in this RFP.

Section 7, Environmentally Friendly Practices:

CONTRACTOR shall summarize all environmentally friendly practices to which it adheres while doing business as relevant to the County’s Climate-Friendly Purchasing Policy:

Section 8, Statement to Service Entire County:

Include a statement acknowledging that CONTRACTOR can service all locations or stipulate which of the following locations CONTRACTOR cannot provide services to: Pajaro, Castroville, Royal Oaks, Salinas, Monterey, Carmel Valley, Marina, Seaside, Prunedale, Aromas, Soledad, King City, and as far reaching in the South County past the San Luis Obispo County border.

If certain locations are to include added fees for travel time, please indicate as such in this statement.

Section 9, Local Business Declaration Form (Attachment C):

CONTRACTOR shall declare whether or not it is a local business in accordance with the County of Monterey’s Local Business Preference Policy.

Section 10, Exceptions:

Submit any and all exceptions to this solicitation on separate pages and clearly identify at the top of each page with “EXCEPTION TO COUNTY RFP #10956”. Each exception shall reference the page number and section number, as appropriate. CONTRACTOR should note that the submittal of an exception does not obligate County to revise the terms of the RFP or AGREEMENT.

Section 11, Appendix:

CONTRACTOR may provide any additional information that it believes to be applicable to this proposal package and include such information in an Appendix section.

8.2. **ADDITIONAL REQUIREMENTS:** To be considered “responsive”, submitted proposal packages shall adhere to the following:

8.2.1. Four (4) sets of the proposal package (one [1] original proposal package marked “Original” plus three [3] copies) shall be submitted in response to this solicitation. Each copy shall include a cover indicating the submitting company name and reference to “RFP #10956”. In addition, submit one (1) electronic version (preferable as a PDF file) of the entire proposal package on a USB memory stick. Additional copies may be requested by County at its discretion.

8.2.2. Proposal packages shall be prepared on 8 ½ x 11 paper, preferably bound with front and back covers. Foldout charts, tables, spreadsheets, brochures, pamphlets, and

other pertinent information or work product examples may be included as Appendices.

- 8.2.3. Reproductions of the County of Monterey Seal shall not be used in any documents submitted in response to this solicitation.
- 8.2.4. CONTRACTOR shall not use white-out or similar correction products to make late changes to their proposal package. Any corrections or late changes must be made by manually striking through the incorrect text and making the correction in BLUE ink. Corrections may be handwritten or typed next to the original text and must be initialed in BLUE ink by the individual signing the proposal package.
- 8.2.5. To validate your proposal package, **submit the SIGNATURE PAGE** (contained herein) **with your proposal package**. Proposal packages submitted without that page will be deemed non-responsive. Proposal package signature on the Signature Page must be manual, in BLUE ink, and included with the original copy of the proposal package. Photocopies of the Signature Page may be inserted into the remaining three (3) proposal package copies.

Please be advised that all information and documents submitted to County by CONTRACTOR shall become non-confidential, non-proprietary, non-trade secret, public records without exception and subject to public disclosure by the County at any time without prior notice to CONTRACTOR, whether pursuant to a request for disclosure or otherwise, including but not limited to disclosure in the course of County's normal procedures to post on the internet or otherwise make available to the general public documents of interest to the public. All interested CONTRACTORS are advised to consider, when deciding what information to include in their submitted proposal package, that such inclusion will result in the information becoming a fully disclosable public record. The County shall not be liable in any way for disclosure of any such records or part thereof related to this RFP or any proposal package, including, but not limited to, evaluations, proposals, or any other information or records. In submitting the information and documents, the CONTRACTOR is agreeing to the County's release of such information and documents under the Public Records Act or the Brown Act, without further notice to the CONTRACTOR, and is agreeing to release, indemnify, and hold harmless the County from any harm that may result to the Proposer or any third party for release of such information and documents. This release and promise to defend and indemnify is given regardless of whether any exemption from disclosure may be available or might have been claimed under applicable

law, and CONTRACTOR's responding to this RFP acknowledge that the decision whether to assert any such exemption will be made in the County's sole discretion. Submission by an interested CONTRACTOR constitutes a complete waiver of any claims whatsoever against the County, and/or its agents, officers, or employees, that the County has violated a vendor's right to privacy, disclosed trade secrets, or caused any damage by allowing the proposal package to be inspected.

Additionally, all proposal packages received by County in response to this RFP shall become the exclusive property of the County. 16.0 RIGHTS TO PERTINENT MATERIALS

All responses, inquiries, and correspondence related to this solicitation and all reports, charts, displays, schedules, exhibits, and other documentation produced by CONTRACTOR that are submitted as part of the submittal will become the property of County when received by County **and may be considered public information under applicable law**. Any proprietary information in the submittal must be identified as such and marked "CONFIDENTIAL INFORMATION" or "PROPRIETARY INFORMATION", in conformity with the specific requirements set forth in Section 8.3, above. County will not disclose proprietary information to the public, unless required by law; however, County cannot guarantee that such information will be held confidential. **As a California government entity, County is subject to the California Public Records Act and other public transparency laws and, as such, cannot guarantee the confidentiality of information marked confidential or proprietary.** County will respond to requests for disclosure of records related to this solicitation in accord with applicable law on disclosure requirements and exemptions to disclosure.

17.0 PIGGYBACK CLAUSE

CONTRACTOR shall indicate below if CONTRACTOR agrees to extend the same prices, terms, and conditions of their proposal to other public agencies that have delivery locations within the State of California limits: ____ Yes ____ No. CONTRACTOR's response to this question will not be considered in award of the AGREEMENT resulting from this solicitation. CONTRACTOR shall maintain and provide to County, upon request, current Safety Data Sheets (SDS) and any other documentation necessary to describe the traits, characteristics, and hazardous properties of the materials being transported.

CONTRACTOR understands and agrees that transportation of hazardous materials requires complete and accurate documentation and full compliance with applicable safety requirements. County shall not be responsible or liable for any accidental or intentional discharge, spill, release, or escape of hazardous materials during transportation or storage under CONTRACTOR's control. County shall further bear no responsibility for CONTRACTOR's failure to properly classify, package, secure, handle, or transport hazardous materials in accordance with applicable law.

CONTRACTOR shall immediately notify County, and all required regulatory agencies of any release, spill, or incident involving hazardous materials during transportation in accordance with applicable notification requirements.

20.0 CLEANUP

- 20.1 Cleanup: During performance and completion of services, CONTRACTOR shall remove all unused equipment and instruments of service, all excess or unsuitable material, trash, rubbish and debris, and legally dispose of same, unless otherwise directed by the AGREEMENT. CONTRACTOR shall leave entire area in a neat, clean and acceptable condition as approved by County.
- 20.2 Waste Removal: Once the collection of waste materials has commenced, CONTRACTOR has exercised control of and taken possession of the waste, and the assumption of risk and liability is solely with CONTRACTOR. 21.0 PREFERENCE FOR LOCAL CONTRACTORS

- 21.2 Rights of First Refusal: Each local supplier who is within five percent (5%) of the lowest responsible bid and who is otherwise responsive and responsible to the call for bids shall be provided the opportunity to reduce the local supplier's bid to the amount equal to the amount of the lowest responsible bid, if the lowest responsible bid is submitted by other than a local supplier. The opportunity to reduce the amount of the bid shall be provided first to the lowest eligible local supplier and, if not accepted by such local supplier within five (5) business days of the opening of bids, who is within five percent (5%) of the lowest responsible bid. In the event an eligible local supplier reduces the bid to the amount of the lowest responsible bid, the eligible local supplier shall be deemed to have provided the lowest responsible bid and shall be awarded the AGREEMENT.
- 21.3 The foregoing provisions apply only to competitive bids that require that contracts be awarded to the lowest responsible bidder. For contracts awarded pursuant to RFPs or requests for quotations, the awarding authority may consider, as one (1) of the factors in determining the most suitable proposal or quotation, whether or not a local supplier submits the proposal or quotation.

21.4.5.1 Vendor either owns, leases, rents or otherwise occupies a fixed office or other commercial building, or portion thereof, having a street address within the Area. Vendor possesses a valid and verifiable business license, if required, issued by a city within the Area or by one of the three counties within the Area when the address is located in an unincorporated area within one of the three (3) counties as defined as "Area";

21.4.5.2 Vendor employs at least one (1) full time employee within the "Area", or if the business has no employees, the business shall be at least fifty percent (50%) owned by one (1) or more persons whose primary residence(s) is located within the "Area";

21.4.5.3 Vendor's business must have been in existence, in Vendor's name, within the "Area" for at least two (2) years immediately prior to the issuance of either a request for competitive bids or request for qualifications for the County.

21.4.5.4 Newly established businesses which are owned by an individual(s) formerly employed by a Local Vendor for at least two (2) years also qualifies for the preference; and

21.4.5.5 If applicable vendor must possess a valid resale license from the State Franchise Tax Board showing vendor's local address within the "Area" and evidencing that payment of the local share of the sales tax goes to either a city within the "Area" or to one (1) of the three (3) counties within the defined "Area".

EXHIBIT B – SAFETY MEETING AND WORK PROCEDURES

1. Think Safety: Plan your work; report hazards to your crew leader/supervisor; the responsibility to follow safety practices and to wear personal safety equipment is yours.
2. Report any injury to crew leader/supervisor immediately.
3. Personal protective equipment to be provided as needed: vest, work gloves, face mask, eye protection, hearing protection, etc.
4. DO NOT go out into roadway unless directed to do so by your crew leader/supervisor.
 - a. Roadway means areas that are normally driven, such as traffic lanes and ramps.
5. In the event of a traffic accident, do not try to help. You are not trained in traffic control. The crew leader/supervisor will assist.
6. Work facing traffic whenever practical, staying as far from moving traffic as possible.
7. No horseplay.
8. No cell phones, pagers, or friends are allowed at the job site.
9. No jumping from vehicles.
10. Assistance should be summoned before attempting to lift excessively heavy or bulky objects.
11. Should you require assistance (water, restroom, injury, etc.), contact your crew leader/supervisor.
12. All persons occupying vehicles shall wear seat belts.
13. All work crews will be properly dressed. You will not work without a shirt, vest, long pants, and appropriate footwear.
14. Allow ample working space to work safely. Socially distance and do not bunch up.
15. Beware of hidden obstructions, unstable terrain, climbing up and down steep slopes, and holes in the ground.
16. Place tools in a safe position so that sharp points are not exposed.
17. If you suspect hazardous waste material (i.e. oil, antifreeze, insecticide) and/or biohazards (i.e. needles, syringes, blood-soaked items), notify your crew leader/supervisor immediately. Do not touch them.
18. All attempts should be made to prevent contact with poison oak plants. See crew leader/supervisor for identification and pre- and post-exposure locations.
