ATTACHMENT B May 28, 2025, Budget Hearings Board-directed Follow-up and Pending Budget Issues For the FY 2025-26 Adopted Budget

The Board of Supervisors considered additional funding requests for FY 2025-26 expenditures and requested follow-up reports and discussion on several funding requests to more thoroughly understand the nature and scope of the issues, impacts, and availability of potential financing options. Board-directed follow-up issues and actions include:

- 1. <u>Information Technology Department</u>—The Board requested additional information about the projected FY 2025-26 cost overruns on the Enterprise Resource Planning (ERP) Replacement project currently in progress.
- <u>Public Works, Facilities and Parks</u> The Board requested a presentation and discussion on the Vehicle Asset Management Program (VAMP), including allocated charges to offices/departments and potential impacts to the program if annual charges are suspended and redirected toward other needs.
- 3. <u>Public Works, Facilities and Parks</u> The Board requested a review of the financing options for the Americans with Disabilities Act Deferred Maintenance/Jail capital improvement project, which has an estimated total cost of \$2,500,000.
- 4. <u>County Administrative Office</u> The Board requested that contributions to The Reservoir for their agricultural technology initiatives and Regenerative California for their waterfront and fisheries initiatives be referred to the Measure AA Subcommittee as a possible funding source for the contributions.
- 5. <u>Sheriff-Coroner</u> The Board requested that the funding request for Axon body cameras from the Sheriff-Coroner's Office be referred to the Measure AA Subcommittee as a possible funding source for the request.
