WHEREAS, on September 25, 2023, the County of Monterey, Department of Emergency Management was awarded the California Assembly Bill 102 (AB 102) allocation of \$20,000,000 for the provision of flood relief for the community of Pajaro through the California Governor's Office of Emergency Services (Cal OES) Grant Subaward; and

WHEREAS, on December 6th, 2023, the Board of Supervisors approved an allocation of \$10,000,000 to support individual and business recovery, to be administered by the Department of Emergency Management in partnership with Non-Profit Disaster Case Management Agencies and the Monterey County Workforce Development Board; and

WHEREAS, the County of Monterey Department of Emergency Management and Workforce Development Board have collaborated to create the Pajaro Unmet Needs Disaster Assistance Program, which has two main components: Individual & Household Assistance and Small Business Assistance; and

WHEREAS, the County of Monterey Workforce Development Board has established a Pajaro Unmet Needs Small Business Disaster Assistance Program to provide assistance to small businesses in the community of Pajaro who experienced losses as a result of the Pajaro levee breach; and

WHEREAS, in order to continue with the Pajaro Unmet Needs Individual and Household Disaster and Assistance Program and the Small Business Assistance program, Department of Emergency Management and Workforce Development Board is requesting that the unspent FY 24 funds to be allocated in FY 2024-25 and increase appropriations for DEM in the amount of 945,475.70 and 2,894,194.18 for WFD.
