Proposed Ordinance Concept

- > Allow Cannabis Lounge Use as an Allowed Use
 - > Cannabis Retailer
 - Ministerial Permit Through Cannabis Program
 - Rigorous Review For Retail Permit
- Need To Meet Requirements
 - > Ventilation
 - Construction to Building Code
- Allow Cannabis Lounge Use Upon Obtaining a Discretionary Permit
 - Need to expand the property to accommodate the lounge use
 - Seek Outdoor Cannabis Lounge



Santa Cruz County Regulations

- > Allow Cannabis Lounge Use as an Allowed Use
 - > Cannabis Retailer
 - > Employee Protection
 - > Ventilation
 - > Separate Area and Access Controls
 - Construction to Building Code
- Public Concerns
 - Impaired Driving
 - Road Conditions
 - Youth Exposure
 - Proximity to School Routes





