WHEREAS, pursuant to Sections 82011 and 87303 of the Government Code, the Department of Emergency Management has submitted its newly established code to the Monterey County Board of Supervisors, the code reviewing body, for approval; and

WHEREAS, the newly established conflict of interest code of the Department of Emergency Management is attached hereto as Attachment 1 and incorporated herein by reference; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to Government Code section 87303, the Board of Supervisors as code reviewing body, may approve the code as submitted, revise the proposed code and approve it as revised, or return the proposed code to the agency for revision and resubmission; and

WHEREAS, the proposed newly established code as adopted is lawful under the Political Reform Act of 1974;

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED THAT, the Board of Supervisors does hereby approve the newly established Conflict of Interest Code of the Department of Emergency Management attached hereto as Attachment A, and directs the Clerk of the Board of Supervisors to notify the Department of Emergency Management of its approval.
