WHEREAS, Monterey County is home to a rich tapestry of voices, cultures, and perspectives, and the protection of free expression ensures that all residents are heard and valued; and

WHEREAS, the County of Monterey reaffirms its commitment to uphold, defend, and protect these constitutional freedoms for all who live, work, and visit here; and

WHEREAS, Free Speech Week provides an opportunity to reflect on the vital role of free expression in our schools, workplaces, media, and civic institutions, and to encourage respectful discourse in our communities;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT PROCLAIMED that the Monterey County Board of Supervisors hereby declares the week of October 20–26, 2025, as Free Speech Week in Monterey County, and encourages residents, organizations, educational institutions, and community partners to celebrate and safeguard the freedoms guaranteed under the First Amendment.
