**RECITALS:**

**WHEREAS**, on September 25, 2023, the County of Monterey, Department of Emergency Management was awarded the California Assembly Bill 102 (AB 102) allocation of \$20,000,000 for the provision of flood relief for the community of Pajaro through the California Governor's Office of Emergency Services (Cal OES) 2023 Winter Storm Flood Relief (WS) Program #WS23 01 0270; and,

**WHEREAS**, on December 6<sup>th</sup>, 2023, the Board of Supervisors approved an allocation of \$500,000 for the North County Fire Protection District (NCFPD) to purchase necessary critical equipment to improve response capabilities to flood events; and

**WHEREAS**, the County of Monterey Department of Emergency Management partnered with NCFPD to identify critical flood response equipment and training to respond to future flood events and purchased it on NCFPD's behalf; and

**WHEREAS**, the County of Monterey Department of Emergency Management has consulted with NCFPD to draft a Memorandum of Understanding governing the ownership and use of this equipment and training.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED**, by the Board of Supervisors in and for the County of Monterey as follows:

Authorize the Director of the Department of Emergency Management or designee to enter into a Memorandum of Understanding with North County Fire Protection District governing the use of all equipment purchased on its' behalf under Assembly Bill 102.
