Mr. Gollnick completed his undergraduate studies in agriculture business at California Polytechnic State University, San Luis Obispo. Mr. Gollnick is the 2023 recipient of the Hartnell Community College Leadership Award. He also served in leadership roles on State and regional agricultural trade associations and nonprofit boards throughout Monterey County, including holding the titles of President or Chairman. Mr. Gollnick has served on the Monterey County Agricultural Advisory Committee for many years sharing his experience with agriculture land uses and familiarity with the Monterey County General Plan.
