SUMMARY:

The County of Monterey is developing a Community Climate Action and Adaptation Plan (CCAAP) to provide a comprehensive framework for mitigating and adapting to climate change for the unincorporated portions of the county. The CCAAP will provide a roadmap for reducing local greenhouse gas emissions while also building resilience to future climate impacts and guiding the county's growth in a sustainable and equitable way.
