

**Amendment No. 1
to the
Standard Agreement
Between ConvergeOne, Inc. and
The County of Monterey, Acting Through Its Information Technology Department
For
Infrastructure Services**

THIS AMENDMENT is made to the Standard Agreement (“Agreement”) dated September 16, 2020, for infrastructure services on an as-needed basis by and between ConvergeOne, Inc., hereinafter “CONTRACTOR” and the County of Monterey, a political subdivision of the State of California, hereinafter referred to as “COUNTY.”

RECITALS

WHEREAS, COUNTY and CONTRACTOR currently wish to amend the Agreement to extend the term through September 30, 2028, and add an additional \$152,000 to continue services on an as-needed basis.

NOW, THEREFORE, the COUNTY and CONTRACTOR hereby agree to amend the AGREEMENT in the following manner:

1. Item 2.0 PAYMENT PROVISIONS: shall be amended to “The total amount payable by County to CONTRACTOR under this Agreement shall not exceed the sum of: \$250,000.00.”
2. Item 3.0 TERM OF AGREEMENT 3.01 shall be amended to “The term of this Agreement is from October 1, 2020, to September 30, 2028.”

Except as provided herein, all remaining terms, conditions and provisions of the AGREEMENT are unchanged and unaffected by this Amendment No. 1 and shall continue in full force and effect as set forth in the AGREEMENT.

A copy of this Amendment No. 1 shall be attached to the original AGREEMENT.


