**Resolution No:**

Adopt a resolution honoring **Ron Johnson** upon his selection as the **Monterey Peninsula Chamber of Commerce 2023 Community Impact Award**.

**WHEREAS**, since 2023, the Monterey Peninsula Chamber of Commerce (MPCC) has awarded distinguished members of our community—who either in the course of their jobs, or during their lives - enhance the well-being of the community, have embodied an overall love of the Monterey Peninsula community, who as great communicators and adept relationship builders have demonstrated community leadership to the citizens of the Monterey Peninsula—with the 2023 Community Impact Award recognizing their good works and accomplishments that have enriched the Peninsula’s and regions quality of life; and

**WHEREAS**, Ron Johnson attended Monterey Peninsula College before transferring to California University, Long Beach, where he earned his bachelor’s degree in Business Management; and

**WHEREAS**, being a two-sport athlete (football and track & field), Ron Johnson was drafted as a wide receiver in the 7th round by the Seattle Seahawks in 1981. After being one of the team’s final cuts, he signed with the Hamilton Tiger-Cats (1981-84) of the Canadian Football League. He was an Eastern All-Star for 3 seasons and played in the Grey Cup in 1984. In 1985, Ron Johnson signed as a free agent with the Philadelphia Eagles where he played for 5 seasons under then head coach, Buddy Ryan; and

**WHEREAS**, Ron Johnson retired from football in 1990 and became an investment advisor for a securities firm in Carmel. He remained in that industry for 2 years before following his true passion; working with youth; and

**WHEREAS**, Ron Johnson currently serves as President & CEO for Boys & Girls Clubs of Monterey County, which he’s been with since 1992. He became involved with the club due to his enjoyment working with young people and wanting to have a positive influence on their lives; and

**WHEREAS**, Ron currently serves as a Trustee at Stevenson School. He has also served as Chair of United Way Monterey County and was a Trustee at All Saints Episcopal Day School. He spends much of his time supporting programs that benefit youth. Ron Johnson served on the President’s Council at California State University Monterey Bay where he was named as a Distinguished Fellow in 1994. He received a 2020 Legacy of Leadership Award from the Salinas Chamber of Commerce and was selected as a member of the 2017 Class of the Junior Achievement Monterey Bay Business Hall of Fame; and

**WHEREAS**, Ron Johnson and his wife Lynn are the proud parents of two sons, Wesley, age 25 and Evan, age 20. They reside in Monterey.
